

CONCLUSIONS OF THE  
INTER-PARLIAMENTARY CONFERENCE OF  
EUROPEAN AFFAIRS COMMITTEES  
PARIS, 16th-17th NOVEMBER 1989

The European affairs committees of the Community member states' parliaments and representatives from the European Parliament met for the first time in Paris, at the invitation of Mr. Laurent Fabius and in accordance with the conclusions of the Madrid Conference on 20th May 1989, under the chairmanship of Messrs Charles Josselin and Jacques Genton, Chairmen of the National Assembly and Senate European Communities Delegations.

Anxious to further increase the involvement of national parliaments in the democratic control of European construction, they adopted the following conclusions:

- 1) The European affairs committees decide to improve their reciprocal information through the systematic exchange of the texts which they adopt, the communication of all useful information on their activities and the development of their mutual relations.
- 2) In the same spirit, they will meet, in principle every six months, in the country holding the presidency of the Community to discuss major topical subjects in the Community and to decide on such in accordance with their respective competence.
